## Congratulations!

At the time of your purchase, your puppy has been thoroughly vet checked and healthy at the time of the sale.

### Here are a few things that can happen when puppy/puppies are in their new homes:

1. Puppies are easily stressed when they travel and adjusting to their new environment. If you are traveling a lengthy distance then they can develop Coccidiosis which will need to be treated, and is easily treated by your vet. Symptoms in young dogs include diarrhea with mucus and blood, poor appetite, vomiting, and dehydration. Untreated, the disease can be fatal.
2. Puppies are stressed, and scared until they get use to their new surroundings. They may not eat for a few days after they are in their new homes - Puppies are like people and need time to adjust.
3. Puppies sometimes are hypoglycemic so we suggest keeping Nutro Cal or Karo syrup on hand. PLEASE KEEP AN EYE OUT FOR SUGAR DROPS IN THE FIRST FEW DAYS OF HAVING YOUR NEW PUPPY!
4. It is recommended that you have a crate and a quiet place for your new puppy to settle in.
5. We recommend that you play with your new puppy, but minimally until it's fully adjusted.
6. It is highly recommended that you do not take your puppy out in public, place it on the ground to potty, and do not let it around other dogs until it has had all its shots - (12 weeks of age). This way you can, and will keep your puppy healthy, and helps prevent Parvo which is the number one killer in puppies. If you allow your puppy to touch the ground, or taken to a public place, and contracts Parvo or any other disease, this health guarantee will become void.
7. Xylitol is extremely toxic to dogs and puppies. Even small amounts of xylitol can cause hypoglycemia (low blood sugar), seizures, liver failure or even death in dogs. Xylitol is a "sugar alcohol," a natural sugar substitute that, because of its anti-cavity properties for human teeth, is commonly found in "sugar-free" gum, mints, toothpastes, and mouthwashes. Since it's also considered a good sugar substitute for diabetics, xylitol is commonly used in sugar-free baked goods too, such as cookies and muffins. Xylitol is also present in some brands of children's chewable vitamins and other supplements. And it's now even being added to certain brands of PEANUT BUTTER! Xylitol is far more toxic to dogs than chocolate, so please double your products.
8. Please treat your new puppy like you would a newborn child. Protect it from the environment and shower it with love.
9. Please do your research of the cost of owning a new pet, including the cost of vet bills, food, medicine, supplies, and toys. Placing puppies in good homes is our top priority and we reserve the right to refuse selling a puppy if we believe it is not a good fit. Please understand we consider these puppies as part of our extended family and want nothing but the best for them in their forever homes.
10. PLEASE SEND US PHOTOS OF YOU AND YOUR NEW FAMILY MEMBER and please tell your friends where you got your new furbaby! Referrals are one of the highest forms of compliments we get! :)

**Your 48-hour guarantee:**

Take your puppy/puppies to your vet to be checked! (It's always best to make an appointment a few days prior to bringing your puppy home). **PLEASE CALL YOUR VET TO INQUIRE ABOUT THE COST OF A WELLNESS EXAM BEFORE PURCHASING YOUR PUPPY! We will NOT be responsible for any costs whatsoever associated with Vet Bills (including the initial checkup / wellness exam) after the puppy leaves our premises.**

If your puppy/puppies are found to have any life threatening issues such as: Heart condition, bone disease, cancer we will gladly refund your money. You must have a written letter from your vet explaining what's wrong with the pup. Letter must have the following info: date seen, vet's name, phone number for contact.

At the time of pick up, the dog is in good health and free of known contagious diseases and has had vaccinations required for its age at the time of this agreement.

We will not be responsible for the following: Coccidia, Parvovirus, Hypoglycemia, umbilical hernia or worms, Giardia, or ear yeast as these are not genetic and common in Puppies.

*Hypoglycemia, or low blood sugar (sometimes called "sugar shock"), is a condition where the blood sugar level drops to an extremely low level due to lack of food, or by using up all stored energy without it being replenished. (Such as when your puppy plays for an extended period of time without eating.) The most common trigger is stress (such as going to a new home). Sugar drops are especially dangerous to small breeds of puppies. PLEASE TREAT YOUR NEW PUPPY LIKE YOU WOULD A BABY AND TAKE EVERY PRECAUTION AGAINST IT HAVING A SUGAR DROP. One way to help prevent this is to feed your new puppy several times a day and especially before going to sleep at night by giving it a small amount of wet food. A good indicator of a puppy's health is the color of its gums. The gums should appear pink in color.*

After the 48 hour health guarantee expires the sale is final. If you choose not to take your puppy to your veterinarian, and have it examined within 48 hours then the health guarantee contract is void, and forfeits all rights to any refund or exchange.

Unless noted, your pup eats three times a day and generally free feed. They are nourished with:

- Purina Puppy Chow (Tender Crunchy)\*
- Mix 3 Tbsp. Pedigree Chopped Chicken\*
- Mix 1 container Cesar's\*
- Mix 2 Tbsp. warm water

\* THESE ITEMS ARE READILY AVAILABLE AT WALMART AND DOLLAR GENERAL. PLEASE DO NOT CHANGE YOUR PUPPY'S DIET UNTIL YOUR VET RECOMMENDS TO. YOUR PUPPY'S TUMMY IS FRAGILE AND ABRUPTLY CHANGING THEIR DIET MAY TRIGGER UNINTENDED PROBLEMS.

### **Precautions to Follow:**

- Do not let your pup on the ground, grass, parking lot or porch until he/she has had all 3 sets of shots: 6 weeks (which is what your puppy just had), 9 weeks, 12 weeks, and rabies at this time.
- Do not let other children play with your puppy if they have pets at home. They can transmit diseases to your pup.
- Do not change their diet the day you get it. Gradually change their diet. Please talk to your vet.
- Place radio/soft music in the room with them for the first few days in a quiet room away from children. Children who are hyper, overly excited, or loud will scare your puppy.
- Buy a crate that will be your pet's safe haven. This is also an easy way to house train your puppy. Pee pads are recommended in this process.
- Puppy play pens are also great to have as you can contain them, and they still have room to play.

### **Physical:**

- We can NOT guarantee your puppy's size as an adult.
- We can NOT guarantee your puppies coat, texture of fur, or if it will be straight, curly or wavy.
- We can NOT guarantee your puppy will not shed. All dogs shed some, no matter what the breed is.
- We can NOT guarantee you pup's colorings as an adult.

### **Puppy/Dog Insights Poodles & Doodles:**

- Will change color until age 2 - IE: you may have a black poodle or doodle that could turn chocolate or blue. This does NOT MEAN THAT YOURS WILL.
- A doodles hair texture can, and will change through their puppy stages until age 2. If you are unfamiliar with doodles then please research them. Doodles will shed a bit during their first year while transitioning from puppy to adult, this is normal.
- Poodles sometimes don't have extremely curly hair as puppies, but will get curlier as they mature. Please remember poodle's hair changes until age 2.
- Know what type of Doodle you're wanting before you purchase one. Here are the types of Doodles: (a). F1, (b) F1b, (c) F2, (d) F2b, (e). Double Doodles.
